In the subject of your e-mail put the author's surname and name, section title (For instance, Ivanov Ivan, Section 6. Philology. 6.1. Foreign Languages and Intercultural Communication).

The papers will be reviewed by the Organizing Committee and the letters of confirmation will be forwarded within 2 working days. The applicants who will not receive the confirmation letter will have to send their materials again.

The Conference Organizing Committee reserves the right to edit the text of the papers (spelling and punctuation). The Organizing Committee also reserves the right to reject the publication of the articles which do not meet the requirements or do not correspond to the topics of the conference. Decisions of the Organizing Committee will not be commented on and subjected to any appeal.

By submitting the article, the author agrees to its publication in the conference proceedings book (for free).

IV. REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ARTICLES

Actuality	The article should be on topical issue and contain the results of deep individual research
Responsibility	The authors of the articles bear legal and other responsibility for the accuracy of the information specified in their scientific works.
Uniqueness	The uniqueness of the article should make no less than 75% of the volume of the text, and self-citation — no more than 25%.

Text Format	Microsoft Word (*.doc, *.docx);
Paging	is not allowed
Line spacing	1.0
Page margins	(upper, lower, left, right) 2 cm;
Font	size (font) — 12;
Font type:	Times New Roman
Text justification	Full
Page size	A4 (210x297 mm.)
Page orientation	Portrait orientation

UDC	Assigning UDC identifier to the article is obligatory
ORCID ID	ID data are obligatory
Annotation	In English
Keywords	In English. No more than 10 words
Bibliography and Internet links list	The sources referred to should be included in the end of the text under the title "Bibliography:" In the text the reference to the source should be indicated in square brackets: the first number corresponds to the number of the source in Bibliography, while the other refers to the number of the page of the source cited). For example: [3, p. 111].
Drawings and tables	All image data used in the article should be of <i>jpg</i> , <i>gif</i> , <i>bmp</i> format. No images done in MS Word. Drawings should be included into the text
	and be clear and black-and-white. Drawing titles and numbers should be given under them. Table titles and numbers should be indicated above them. Diagrams should be presented as drawings.
Paragraph indention	1,00 (No spacing and tabulation in the beginning of the paragraph!)
Text	No hyphenation. Pages should not contain separations, running titles, foot-notes, notations.
Number of coauthors	No more than three coauthors.
