Within the scope of Erasmus + KA171 project, a joint project was carried out with Republic of Türkiye, **Karabük University** in the field of **Turkish and English Languages**. Within the scope of the project, **1 Long Term Student Learning Mobility** will be carried out in the 2025-2026 academic year in line with the following criteria.

The period expected to participate in the activity is the **fall semester of 2025-2026**. Our students will participate in the activity for **4 months**.

Students who will participate in the activity must meet the following minimum requirements:

Application Requirements for Student Learning Mobility

1. To be a full-time student enrolled in Comrat State University **Turkish (Gagauzian) or English Languages** undergraduate programme
2. To have a GPA of at least 7.00
3. For study mobility: sufficient number of ECTS credits (at least 30 ECTS)
4. If the activities have been utilised previously within the current education level, the total duration together with the new activity should not exceed 12 months
5. At least 50 English Language Score for Vocational Schools

Application Procedures

The announcement process for the KA171 Student Learning Mobility between Karabük University and our University is between **February 10 - March 02, 2025 (3 weeks period)**, and the application process will be taken online to internationalofficecsumd@gmail.com between **March**

03 - March 16, 2025 (2 weeks period).

Student Selection Criteria

1. The selection of students is carried out from among the students who apply by fulfilling the requirements, taking into account the evaluation criteria and weighted scores recommended by the National Agency.
2. Success score is calculated as academic grade point average 50% + language level 50%.

The evaluation criteria and weighted scores to be used in evaluating mobility applications are given below:

Table-1 Selection Criteria and Weighted Score Table

Status	Weighted Score
GPA	50% (out of a total of 100 points)
Language level	50% (out of a total of 100 points)
Disabled students (provided that the disability is documented)	+10 points
Previous KA171 mobility experience (with or without grant)	-10 points
Participation in mobility in the country of citizenship	-10 points

- Deductions are made based on the student's total score.

- Students who meet the minimum requirements will be able to waive the financial support in case they remain in the reserve and can participate in the mobility within the quotas without grant if they wish.
