5. Conditions of Participation

Working languages of the conference: Gagauzian, Romanian, Russian, English, Ukrainian, Bulgarian, and Turkish.

Forms of participation:

- in-person – presentation with a report (with publication of the paper in the conference proceeding / with no publication),

- online (only for foreign participants) – presentation with a report via ZOOM (with publication of the paper in the conference proceeding / without publication).

6. Terms of Participation:

All participants must send the Application Form to be included into the Conference programme and to have the article published in the conference proceedings' collection.

8. Publication Requirements:

1. Application

2. The article (see *Appendix*) (in case of participation with publication of the paper in the conference proceeding)

File name: Section number № _Author's Surname_ article; For example: 4_Uzun_article.

The submitted materials must correspond to the main thematic areas of the conference. The authors are fully responsible for the content of the articles. The text of the article must be carefully examined by the author and supervisor and checked for plagiarism. The originality of the text of the paper must be **at least 65 %**.

9. Requirements for the Article Design

Materials must be prepared in the text editor Microsoft Word for Windows. The volume of work is 4-5 pages. Page format – A4. Page orientation is portrait. Margins: left, right, top, bottom – 2 cm. Font format: size – 12; type – Times New Roman; line spacing – single, red line 1.2 mm. Separating red lines with tabs and spaces is not allowed.

- **INDEX** according to the universal decimal classification (UDC) (point size 12, left aligned),
- **ARTICLE TITLE** (in capital letters, bold, aligned to the center of the line);
- in a line – **the author's surname and initials** (in bold italics, right-aligned);
- on the next line – the abbreviation of the academic group; on the next line – the student's E-mail;
- on the next line – the initials and surname of the scientific supervisor, indicating the position, scientific title and academic degree (in italics, right aligned);
- on the next line – the abbreviated official name of the educational institution, locality (in italics, right aligned);
- next line is followed by Abstract in English,
- below – Key words in English;
- next – the text of the article follows every other line.

Do not use subscripts, headers or footers in the text. In the text, you should distinguish between dashes and hyphens.

The bibliographic list is required and is placed at the end of the article after the subtitle Bibliographic (Reference) list, numbered without using automatic numbering. References in the text should be in square brackets to the corresponding source of the bibliographic list, for example [1]. The use of automatic pagination links is not allowed.

10. Requirements for the Contest of Students' Works

The submitted articles must correspond to the main thematic areas of the conference.

The contest work must **correspond to the structure** of the scientific work and include the following elements:

- Output data of the article (formatted according to the sample, see *Appendix*);
- introduction (describes the relevance of the topic, purpose, objectives, object and subject of research, practical and/or theoretical significance of the results);
- main part (contents of the work);
- conclusion (contains the main conclusions that the author came to during the research process);
- bibliographic (reference) list (the text of the work must contain links to each scientific source indicated in the bibliographic list (the reference number corresponds to the serial number of the source in the list of references).

Oral Presentation Requirements

The participant's presentation should present the main points of the submitted article and demonstrate the results of the research. The presentation should last up to 7 minutes. During the presentation, the participant should:

- clearly formulate the topic, purpose, and objectives of the study;
- briefly present the main points and results of the work;
- demonstrate the logic, scientific validity, and argumentation of the presentation;
- present the main conclusions and practical significance of the study.

Presentation Requirements

Speaking must be accompanied by a multimedia presentation.

The presentation must:

- outline the main stages and results of the research;
- include a title slide (title of the work, author's name, educational institution, and scientific adviser);
- include the main points of the research, results, and conclusions;
- be visual, logically structured, and concise;
- include graphics (diagrams, tables, charts, illustrations), if necessary.

The recommended length of the presentation is 8–10 slides.

Competition Evaluation Criteria

The jury evaluates submitted works based on the following parameters:

- Relevance of the research topic;
- Logicality and soundness of the structure of the scientific article;
- In-depth analysis of the problem being studied;
- Correct use of scientific sources;
- Quality of the article's presentation.

The oral presentation of the work (report) is also assessed:

- the content and logic of the report;
- the author's ability to present the main research findings;
- the culture of scientific discourse and the argumentation of answers to questions;

If the article is accepted for publication, the author will be notified within one week via the email address specified in the application. Submissions submitted after the deadline will not be considered.
