FOR FOREIGN CITIZENS ADMISSION TO COMRAT STATE UNIVERSITY

Comrat State University comprises four faculties: the Faculty of National Culture, the Faculty of Economics, the Faculty of Law, and the Faculty of Agricultural Technology.

The university offers higher education at the first cycle (Bachelor's degree) and the second cycle (Master's degree).

International students have the opportunity to pursue higher education in eight Bachelor's programmes and four Master's programmes.

As part of the Bologna Process for the integration of education systems, student and academic mobility has been enhanced through the university's participation in projects funded by the European Commission – ERASMUS+, ERASMUS MUNDUS, TEMPUS and DAAD – as well as the US Fulbright Programme, which facilitates the mobility of both teaching staff and students.

To consolidate the knowledge gained through the university's study programmes, the following facilities are available on campus: the Centre for Continuing Education and Guidance in Careers, the Information Technology Centre, the Business Centre, the 'InnoCentre' Innovation Incubator, the 'Euraxess' Centre, the European Union Information Centre, the Educational Centre for Modern Technologies for Civil Servants, and the Centre for Youth Initiatives. The university also hosts a number of centres for the study of the languages and cultures of various foreign countries, established with the support of the embassies of Germany, the USA, the UK, Turkey, Azerbaijan, Hungary, Romania, Greece, and others.

The university has a student council that represents students' interests.

The university has a well-appointed student residence and laboratories, and students are also able to train and keep fit at the university's sports complex.

Student life is not limited solely to academic classes and examination sessions. It also includes engaging leisure activities. The institution regularly hosts evening events and student concerts, discos, and art exhibitions.

Foreign nationals may be admitted to study at CSU following an interview to assess their knowledge of the Russian language, or upon submission of academic documents (certificates, etc.) confirming their proficiency in the language.

Foreign nationals who do not possess the language skills required for admission to Bachelor degree programmes are required to attend the Preparatory Department to study the Russian Language at CSU, in order to prepare for admission to the study programmes offered to foreign nationals.

The Preparatory Department programme lasts 10 months. Upon completion, students will have attained the necessary level of Russian proficiency to continue their studies at CSU in the specialties chosen and to feel at ease in all aspects of life in Moldova.

No entrance examinations are required for admission to the university's **Preparatory Department**. CSU's Preparatory Department accepts students from countries outside the CIS and international students from CIS countries.

Tuition fees for the Preparatory Department are 600 euros (€).

Accommodation is provided in the Comrat State University hall of residence, located at 152 Tretyakov Street, Comrat. The university's hall of residence are suite-style, comprising two rooms — one designed for double occupancy and the other for four occupants — a bathroom, and an entrance hall. **The cost of accommodation per bed (per resident) is 7,000 lei per year.**

In addition, students in the Preparatory Department may also rent accommodation in the private sector; rental costs range from 300 to 350 euros per month (depending on the type of accommodation).

Upon completion of the Preparatory Department, CSU admits students without restriction to the following **Bachelor's degree programmes**:

Documents Required for Foreign Nationals' Admission to Comrat State University

When applying to Comrat State University, foreign nationals must submit the following documents:

1. The original secondary school leaving certificate, including a record of grades (transcript);
2. The passport must be valid for a period of no less than one year from the date of entry into the territory of the Republic of Moldova.
3. An original certificate of no criminal record (police clearance certificate), issued by the competent authorities of the country of permanent residence.

Important: The certificate of no criminal record must remain valid at the time of entry into the territory of the Republic of Moldova. Otherwise, the applicant will be required to obtain a new document.)

4. A medical certificate confirming the absence of any medical contraindications and stating negative results for HIV/AIDS testing.
5. A medical insurance policy (international standard) with a validity of at least one year, and issued in the English language.
6. A copy of the birth certificate (or marriage certificate or proof of change of surname, where applicable).
7. A bank account statement confirming the availability of at least €2,500 (two thousand five hundred euros) in the personal account. The statement must be issued no more than 10 days prior to the date of submission of the documents.
8. A language proficiency certificate for those opting for study programmes taught in Russian or Romanian.

If the above-listed documents are presented in a language other than Russian, Romanian, or English, a notarized translation into one of the aforementioned languages must be attached to each document.

All original documents and their translations must be legalized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and apostilled in accordance with the official procedure of the respective country, and subsequently submitted to the International Students' Office at Comrat State University.

International students who are citizens of non-CIS countries (Turkey, the United States, the European Union member states, Africa, South America, Latin America, and others) are required to obtain a **STUDENT VISA** from the embassy of their home country in order to enroll at Comrat State University. To do so, an official letter of invitation from Comrat State University is necessary, **which may be obtained following the submission of the required documents.**
