Submission of materials and applications

Materials and participant's application **for each of the directions of the conference are sent** to the above e-mail addresses (marked "Science to Practice-2022")

Applications for participation in the conference and articles are accepted **until May 7, 2022.**

The file name must include the author's surname and initials, city, the number of the scientific direction, for example: **Ivanov_AV_Baranavichy_2.**

One author can submit **no more than two** articles, including co-authorship.

The registration of the materials provided is guaranteed by an e-mail message about their receipt.

The editorial board carries out an independent (closed) expertise of the submitted materials and carries out their additional reviewing. There is no discussion on the reasons for the rejection. The authors are responsible for sending to the editorial office articles previously published or accepted for publication by other editions.

Conference materials will be indexed in the **RSCI.**

The publication of the collection of conference materials is planned **after** the event as a printed edition, **the participants of the conference are provided with an electronic copy of the original edition by e-mail (PDF-format) (December 2022).**

Requirements for the presentation of materials

1. Technical requirements.

Materials are typed in MS Word editor. **The volume of an article** for the collection of conference materials is **8.000—10.000 printed characters** of the author's material (this volume includes text, tables, references and figures);

A4 format is used for articles; paragraph indent - **10 mm**; indent for the left margin - **20 mm**, top - **20 mm**, right - **22 mm**, bottom - **24 mm**. The font of the main text is **10 pts**, auxiliary (information about the author, references, captions under figures, headings and table contents) - **8 pts**; **single line** spacing.

Pages are not numbered. Page orientation - book only; the use of automatic end and footnotes in the article is not allowed; hyphenation is not allowed; all text is typed in Times New Roman font;

2. Content and presentation of the required elements.

– **index of the Universal Decimal Classification (UDC)**: is compulsory; drawn up in a separate line on the left before the information about the authors, light typeface, auxiliary font;

– **information about authors**:

- given name(s) and surname (bold typeface, 8 pts);
- place of study/work (**official name of the educational institution or scientific organization** is provided **in full according to the Charter of the institution/organization**, locality, italic, auxiliary font);
- name of the country (full official name, italic, auxiliary font).

The names of the co-authors of the article are given in the sequence adopted by them.

Information about authors should be in the language of the article. A footnote is placed at the bottom of the page — an author's mark with surname and given name(s) of the author of the article; then the year is indicated separated by commas (© Ivanov Ivan, 2021).

Information about authors is placed before the name of the article, highlighting by printing means.

– **heading**: placed in the centre before the text, in capital letters (main font), bold typeface; the heading should be in the language of the main text of the article;

– **main text**: page width alignment, light typeface, with the author highlighting the necessary parts of the text in bold (**Introduction, Main part, Conclusion**);

– **tables**: table heading is located on a separate line on the left, without indent; continuous numbering in Arabic numerals; if there is one table in the article, it must also be numbered (Table 1 — Name of the Table); all tables should be referenced in the text, when referring, the word “table” should be written with the number;

– **formulae**: all formulae, as well as symbols of the Greek alphabet and others, used in formulae, in the text should be typed using the MathType formula editor; main font; variables denoted in Latin symbols are typed in italics; Greek ones — in direct; mathematic signs, abbreviated mathematic terms are typed in direct typeface; abbreviations in indexes in Russian are typed in direct; any brackets – in direct typeface; number of formula — in parentheses, placed along the right side on a single line with a formula; it is necessary to number only those formulae to which there are references; when deciphering distinguishing letters it is necessary to put them in the order of their appearance in a formula;

– **figures:** are inserted into the text as an embedded object without text wrapping; graphs and diagrams, prepared in MS Excel, **should not contain colour filling and outlines**, greyscale fills; continuous numbering in Arabic numerals, after the number there is an em-dash and capture is indicated (Figure 1 — Figure title); figure caption - at the bottom, center alignment without a paragraph; if there is only one figure, then it is also numbered; Each figure must be referenced in full with a number. If an illustration placed under one number includes several images, then the theme of each can be defined in the caption as follows:

Figure 12 — Design of the end strip: *a* — a strip with the plot ending;
b — a strip with the ornamental ending

or

Figure 12 — Design of the end strip with the plot (*a*) and ornamental (*b*) ending

Numerical and alphabetic symbols, explained in the main capture and in the explication, are typed in italics;

It is not allowed to present the same result in the form of an illustration and a table;

– *cited bibliographic lists:* **INFORMATION ON SOURCES SHOULD BE PRESENTED IN THE ORDER OF APPEARANCE OF CITATION AND NOT IN ALPHABETICAL ORDER**; title “References” and numbered in Arabic numerals with a dot from the paragraph indent, drawn up in full accordance with the requirements of GOST 7.1-2003 Bibliographic record. Bibliographic description.

General requirements and compilation rules. References in the text are given in the following way: [reference number, page]. For example [1, P. 30]; [2, P. 80; 5, P. 112].

3. When typing the main text you should set:

1) a non-breaking space between the surname and initials, as well as between generally accepted abbreviated words like, etc., V. A. Ivanov.

2) signs hyphen (“- “), minus (“-“) or dash (“—“).

3) Use the following quotation marks: in Russian — «__», in English — “_”, in German — „_“, in French — « ___ ». In foreign words, an apostrophe is put in the form of a comma (country’s).
