

REQUIREMENTS FOR WRITING MATERIALS
for the International Scientific and Practical Conference on
„Women, Peace and Security Agenda:
Ensuring Human Security, Promoting Sustainable Peace
and Preventing Conflicts”
October 28-30, 2020

The paper should be typed in MS Word.

Structure of the article:

Title – capital letters, font 14, Times New Roman, Bold;

Authors – indicate name, surname, degree and scientific title, institution and position (written in full), right alignment, font 12, Times New Roman, Italic;

Summary/Abstract – up to 150 words, in the language in which the article is written, font 11, Times New Roman, Italic, 1,0 interval;

Keywords – 7-10 notions and scientific terms used in the article, font 11, Times New Roman, Italic, 1,0 interval;

Textul de bază – up to 12 pages, without page numbering, format A4-portrait, font 12, Times New Roman, 1,5 interval; fields: left – 3,0 cm, up/down – 1,5 cm, right – 1,0 cm.

The tables/graphics/pictures are inserted in the text as „Table/Fig. no. 1: The Title”. Their sources (if any) are referred to as footnotes.

Bibliographic references – will be inserted at the bottom of the page (font 10, Times New Roman), in the form: Author's name, surname, the name of the paper (Italic), locality, publisher, year of publication and page. For Internet sources, specify all available bibliographic elements and the complete link, the date of access. The titles of the papers will be written in the language in which they were consulted (for example, the titles of the papers are not translated from Romanian into English and vice versa).

The **bibliography** is presented (according to the Decision of the Attestation Commission of National Council for Accreditation and Attestation of the Republic of Moldova no. AT03 of April 23, 2009), as follows:

- a) normative acts: name of the act, number, date of approval, source of publication;
- b) journals and articles: name(s) of the author(s), title of the article, title of the journal, accepted abbreviations, publication year, volume, number, first and last page;
- c) books: name(s) of the author(s), complete title, publisher, editing place, publication year, number of pages;
- d) in the case of bibliographic sources in electronic format, the URL address and the date of visiting the web page are additionally indicated, according to the following models:

The list of references must be within reasonable limits.

References to papers that have not yet gone out of print are not accepted.

The title and abstract of the article will be sent by October 15, 2020, and the article finalized for publication will be sent by November 15, 2020, to the e-mail address: conferencewps2020@gmail.com.

The paper will be sent in electronic format, with the extension ".doc"/".docx" (a single file for a paper) as an attachment, being named as follows: „Name and surname of the first author .doc” (example: „Popescu Ion.doc”).

Following the conference, a collection of articles will be edited and published.

The materials presented without respecting the topic of the conference, the mentioned requirements or submitted after the deadline, will not be considered.
