Participant certificates. Report submitting participants will receive a speaker certificate (e-format). The listeners of the conference who filled in the application form for participation will receive an auditor certificate (e-format).

Collection of conference materials. Materials that have successfully passed the review will be published in the e-collection of scientific papers of the conference. All articles are tested in the Antiplagiat system. The submitted material must have an original text of at least 70%. The volume of the article is **4-6 full pages**.

CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

Deadline for submitting the articles is **November 30, 2024** (10.00 p.m.). The articles should be submitted to the emails of the organizing committee (by sections).

The authors of the articles are responsible for the content and literacy of the submitted materials.

The number of articles from one author (co-authors) is limited to one publication. The number of co-authors - no more than three.

Participation in the conference and publication of materials is free of charge.

Following the results of the conference a collection of its materials will be published and assigned an international ISBN index.

The volume of an article should be **4-6 pages** of printed text format-A4.

Requirements for the text:

- Universal Decimal Classification (UDC) index (point 12, left-alignment),
- ORCID ID (code assigned to the author for unambiguous identification of his works and research results, address for registration in case of its absence: <https://orcid.org/>);
- **ARTICLE NAME** (center alignment, capital letters, bold font);
- **surname, first name, patronymic name** (right-alignment, bold), academic degree, academic title, place of work, city, country, e-mail (right-alignment);
- abstract (5-6 lines in English);
- keywords (5-6, in English);
- across the line - the main text of the manuscript (Times New Roman, font size 12, line spacing 1.5, indent - 1.25, all margins - 2 cm, Word text editor).
- Figures and tables (images used in the article should be of the following formats: jpg, gif, bmp. Images made in MS Word are not accepted. Figures should be inserted into the text and be clear, black and white. Title and numbers of figures should be indicated under the figures; names and numbers of tables - above the tables, diagrams should be presented as figures).
- The list of the sources used should be presented in alphabetical order after the main text.

References in the text must be given in square brackets, indicating the number in the reference list and the page number [1, p. 25]
