### III. HOW TO BECOME A CONFERENCE PARTICIPANT

1. Complete the <https://forms.gle/YbPQUe9opk6WpikC8> by **January 20, 2026**;
2. Submit your article, consisting of at least 3 pages and no more than 1 article (including co-authorship), by **February 1, 2025**, to the email addresses of the conference section coordinators;
3. Indicate in the subject line and body of the email: the author's full name and section (Example: Petr Calac, Section 6. Philology. Subsection: Foreign Languages)

Upon receiving the materials, the Organizing Committee will review their content within 2-3 business days and send a confirmation email to the author. Participants who do not receive confirmation are asked to resend their materials. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to make orthographic and technical edits according to the formatting requirements of the conference proceedings. The Committee also reserves the right to reject articles that do not meet the specified requirements and/or topics. The Committee's decision is final and not subject to appeal. Submission of the article implies the author's consent for publication without remuneration

#### IV. REQUIREMENTS FOR PUBLISHING IN THE CONFERENCE PROCEEDINGS

Relevance	The article must be written on a current topic and contain the results of in-depth independent research
Responsibility	The authors are responsible for the content of the materials
Text uniqueness	The text uniqueness must be at least 75%, and self-citation should not exceed 25% of the total material
Article length	The article should be 3-6 pages long on A4 format
Text format	Microsoft Word (*.doc, *.docx)
Page numbering	Not applicable
Margins	top, bottom, left, right – 20 mm
Paragraph indentation	1.00 (no spaces or tabs at the beginning of paragraphs)
Line spacing	1.0
Font type	Times New Roman
Font size	12
Text alignment	Justified alignment
Page size	A4 (210x297 mm), portrait orientation
UDC (Universal Decimal Classification)	Assigning a UDC index to the article is mandatory
ORCID ID	ID information is mandatory
The language of the scientific publication	Romanian, Gagauz, English, Russian, Turkish
Abstract	in English is required
Keywords	In English must not exceed 10 words
Text	No hyphenation. Pages should not contain breaks, headers, footers, or notes
References and footnotes	References should be included at the end of the text in the "Bibliography:" section. In the text, sources are marked with square brackets, indicating the source number from the list and, separated by a comma, the page number. Example: [3, p. 111-114]
Figures and tables	Images must be in jpg, gif, bmp formats; images created in MS Word are not accepted. Figures should be inserted into the text and be clear. Figure titles and numbers should be placed below, while table titles and numbers above. Diagrams are considered figures. The source should be indicated below figures or tables. Example: Source: [3, p. 111-114]. If the publication's author created the scheme, figure, etc., it should state: Source: Created/developed by the author(s) of the publication.
Number of co-authors	A maximum of three co-authors is allowed
The number of scientific research publications by an author in the conference collection (either individually or in co-authorship)	Shall not exceed one publication
