ATU Gagauzia is an autonomous region in Republic of Moldova Traditional female roles dominated historically.

Since 2000: growing involvement in business, education, politics.

Goal: document progress and identify challenges

Education & Digitalization



65% of Comrat State University (ATU Gagauzia, Republic of Moldova) students are women. Digital skills help drive empowerment



Women's Digital Competencies



Women Hub Comrat (2022) by Tekwill, Sweden, UNDP. 250+ trained in e-commerce & remote work in ATU Gagauzia. Example: Anna Karaseni's online handmade store



Women and Economy



UNDP grants (2021–2023) supported 50+ women in ATU Gagauzia.

Fields: bakeries, farms, salons, education.

Case: Lidia Tomai's cheese business



EU-Supported Entrepreneurship





EU grant upgraded Tomai's equipment.
Sales in Chișinău and Bolhrad.
7 women employed in ATU Gagauzia

ODA grants focus on cities.
Rural women lack info, legal aid, bank access in Republic of Moldova




